Clinicians often suspect speech difficulties in young children under 36 months with limited expressive abilities but they find it challenging to provide intervention when children don't have the attention or skills to participate in structured therapy activities. - Identification and evaluation of young children with suspected speech sound disorders
- A developmentally appropriate parent/caregiver – child intervention program that is based on current best practice and research principles.
- Training and coaching parents/caregivers to be the primary implementors of intervention

- introduction to an early speech program ("Play and Say I") that provides a framework for developing a young child's speech learning and production skills while promoting parent/caregiver speech stimulation skills
- how to apply motor learning principles and structure learning opportunities
- How to establish a diagnostic perspective using RTI to determine severity and next steps in service delivery
